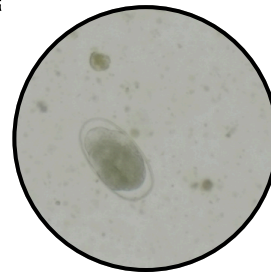

WHY SHOULD YOU GET A FECAL EGG COUNT?

- To know which parasites your horse has to select the correct dewormer
- To determine the horse's shedding level and worming protocol for the year
- To use it in a fecal egg count reduction test to determine dewormer efficacy



HOW TO SUBMIT A FECAL SAMPLE

- Provide one sample per horse
- Horses should not have been dewormed within 6 weeks of fecal collection
- Collect a fresh fecal sample (<2 hours old) in a sandwich-size Ziploc bag and refrigerate until it is brought in for analysis
- Drop off your sample in a properly labelled bag to the store within 5 days of analysis along with a submittal form
- Results and recommendations will be provided once they are determined
